



## Lindale City Councilman Charles W. Morphis

February 3, 1931 - April 6, 2012

Memorial services for Lindale City Councilman Charles W. Morphis are scheduled for 10:30 AM Saturday April 14, 2012 in the chapel of Caudle-Rutledge Funeral Home in Lindale with the Rev. Bryan Tema officiating.

Charles was born on February 3, 1931 to Homer L. Morphis and Iva Ruth Weatherall Morphis of Edgewood, Texas. He began his professional career as a truck driver for Tyler Pipe and later, Western Foundry, where he eventually went into the sales. In the mid-1970s, Charles moved to the Dallas area and became a real estate broker, owning and operating an office in Plano. In 1988, he moved to San Diego, California and became Chief Engineer for Avalon Properties. Retiring in 2003, Charles returned to Texas to help his son open Hank's Auto in Lindale. During that time, local city government began to peak his interest and in 2007, he campaigned successfully for Lindale City Council, Place 5, where he continued to proudly serve until his untimely passing on Friday, April 6.

Charles was preceded in death by his daughter, Charla Sadler of Hawkins. He is survived by a sister, Macie Aycock of Newnan, Georgia; a daughter, Susan Morphis Brizendine of Tyler; a son and daughter-in-law, Bob and Diann Neill of North Hollywood, California; and a son and daughter-in-law, Hank and Pam Morphis of Lindale. He is also survived by ten grandchildren and four great-grandchildren.
