A gathering of friends and family for Lois Juanita (Sullivan) Chambers, age 90, of Salado, Texas is scheduled for 3:00 p.m. Saturday, February 9, 2019 at the Caudle-Rutledge-Daugherty Funeral Home Chapel in Lindale, Texas with Rev. John Roach officiating. Interment will follow at the Lindale City Cemetery. Lois passed away after a short illness, Monday, February 4, 2019 in Temple, Texas.

She was born August 29, 1928 in Midland, Texas to the late Walter and Edna Mae (Sherman) Sullivan. Before moving to Salado, Lois lived in The Woodlands, Texas following years of living in the Lindale area and living overseas.
