She never wanted to miss an opportunity to be with her grandchildren—they were her pride and joy. She also spent many Wednesday nights teaching 4th and 5th graders about God, and loved volunteering for the Vacation Bible School. Lynda is survived by her husband Walter Porsch of Lindale, Texas; daughter and son-in-law, Heather and Jason Lemoine of Lindale, Texas; grandchildren Jake and Lillian Lemoine; sisters, Sandra Miller, Barbara Cleghorn and Theresa Patrick; brother Michael Vaughn; and numerous nieces and nephews. 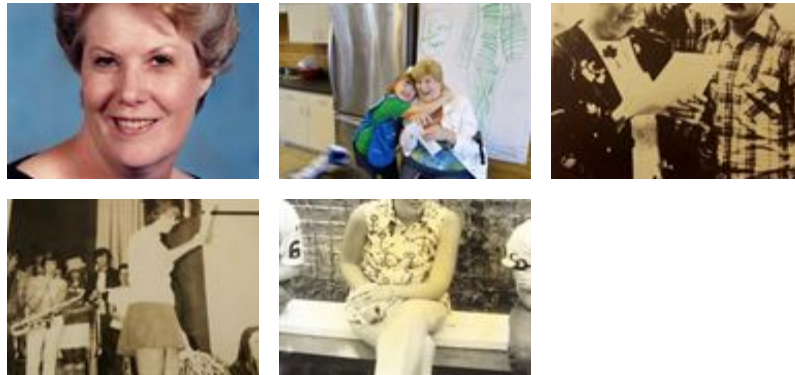
