Athleticism? She loved to ride horses and motorcycles. She water skied, and she constantly worked outside in her garden and her many flower beds. She played on volleyball and softball teams. She loved animals of all kinds and loved raising shelties for several years.....all with a big smile on her face. She loved the Lord and is now loving him up close. She loved people, her life, and her family. She was a strong presence in her evolving family structure.

Her family moved from Oklahoma to Winnsboro when she was a Senior in high school. She met DeLon Saxon and married him when WWII was starting. She was a "Rosie the Riverter" and a great mom to David and Nancy. Later she became the wife of Bill Jump and inherited a beautiful daughter, Phyllis. Margie married Troy Matlock after Bill's death, and then she gained Terry and Lois Matlock and their precious family. They were married for 30 years before Troy passed away.

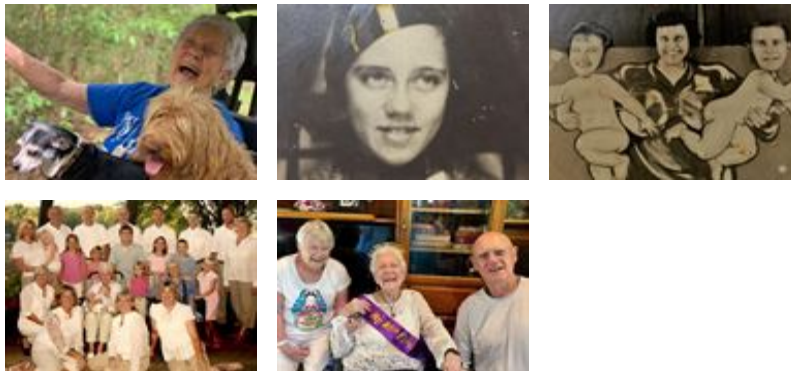
