A Tribute for Marvin "Rose Man" Edwards , age 82 of Lindale, Texas, is scheduled for

Marwill passed away on Thursday, October 10, 2024, in Tyler, Texas. He was born February 10, 1942, in Tyler to the late Marwill James and Eunice (Mapps) Edwards. Marwill has lived in Lindale since 2021 and was previously a longtime resident of Los Angeles, California before moving back to Tyler in 1986. He attended both Tyler Junior College and Sierra College. Throughout Marwill's life he had the pleasure, as a singer and entertainer, of bringing a smile to the faces and joy to the hearts of many. In 1984 Marwill sang in the choir that was featured on the Kenny Rogers and Dolly Parton television special, "A Christmas to Remember". During his lifetime of performances Marwill often gave away roses and after retirement he then sold roses for many years at jazz clubs and Pubs, and became affectionately known as, Roseman. He will forever be remembered as the best dressed guy in town. Marwill was preceded in death by daughter, Linda K. Edwards; his 5 brothers.

He is survived by his son, Pastor James Edwards and wife, Tammy of Lindale; mother of his children, Belzora McGowan Edwards of Tyler; stepdaughter,

Betty Walker and husband, Paul; sisters, Everyn Edwards of Dallas, Shirley Edwards Brown of Duncanville, and Barbara Black of Tyler; 3 grandsons, Denzell Robertson, Jordan Robertson, and James Edwards Jr; best friend, Jeff Daugherty of Lindale, and a host of nieces, nephews and other loving family and friends.

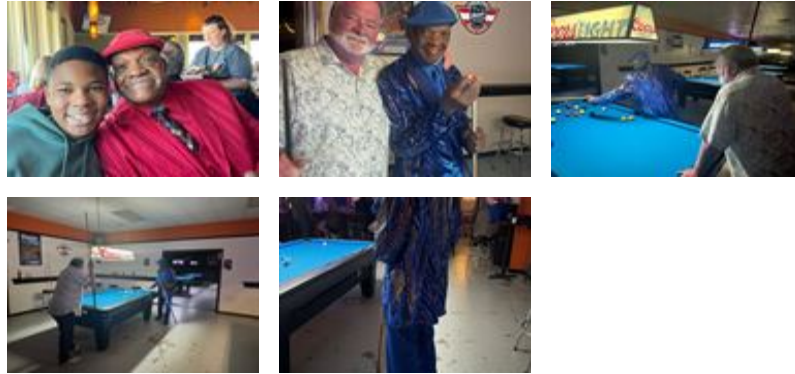

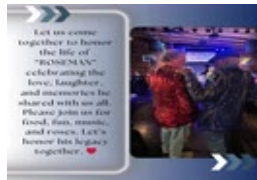

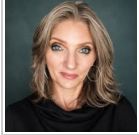
