



## Max L. Dalton

June 24, 1935 - August 21, 2017

Graveside services for Mr. Max L. Dalton, age 82, of Hideaway, Texas are scheduled for 11:00 A.M. Friday, August 25, 2017 in the Lindale City Cemetery with Rev. Mike Biggs officiating. Services are under the direction of Caudle-Rutledge-Daugherty Funeral Home in Lindale, Texas. Mr. Dalton died Monday, August 21, 2017 at his residence in Hideaway. He was born on June 24, 1935 in Lawton, Oklahoma to the late Ernest Dewey and Mary Odetta (Akes) Dalton. Mr. Dalton served in the National Guard and worked for the Army/Air Force Exchange Service which set up foreign exchange stores for American military personnel all over the world. He and his family were also the first civilians to go into Korea with AAFES. Mr. Dalton was a licensed HAM radio operator and a member of the Hideaway Lake Community Church. He was preceded in death by his son, Michael Dalton in 2011 and brother, Don Dalton.

Mr. Dalton is survived by his wife of 64 years, Edrie Dalton of Hideaway, Texas; daughter & son-in-law, Cheryl & Kip Sutherland of Whitehouse, Texas; 3 grandchildren, Christina Davis, Miranda Lewis, and Kyle Sutherland; 9 great grandchildren, Camden, Hope, Dalton, Brooke, Kadyn, Logan, Grayson, Emily, and Max. 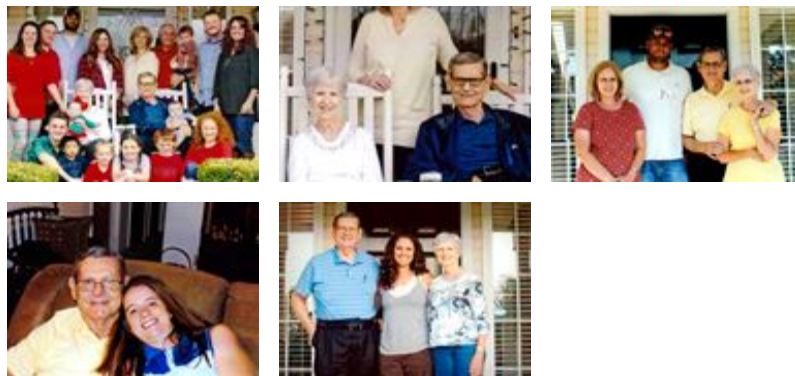
