Funeral service for Mrs. Melody Robinson Whiteside, age 62 of Lindale are scheduled for 2:00 PM Saturday August 9, 2014 in the chapel of Caudle-Rutledge Funeral Home in Lindale. The Rev. Byron Howard will officiate and burial will follow in the Lindale City Cemetery. Mrs. Whiteside died Tuesday August 5, 2014 in a Tyler hospice center. She was born April 2, 1952 in Conroe, Texas the daughter of the late Wesley Ray and Georgiale Skinner Robinson, and was a lifelong resident of the Lindale area.
