



## Michael Burrow

May 24, 1943 - July 16, 2016

Michael Burrow, age 73, of Tyler, Texas died Saturday, July 16, 2016 in a Tyler hospice center. A memorial service will be held 10:00 AM Saturday, July 23, 2016 at the Southern Oaks Baptist Church in Tyler. Mr. Burrow was born on May 24, 1943 in Magnolia, Arkansas to the late Wilbur J. and Sarah Geraldine (Gray) Burrow. Michael has more than 25 years experience as a journalist, serving as a reporter, editorial page editor, city editor and managing editor of newspapers in Southwest Arkansas, including Magnolia Banner News, and in East Texas with the Tyler Morning Telegraph. He published two separate weekly newspapers and when he was in his early twenties, created and published a quarterly literary magazine entitled EXPRESSION in his hometown of Magnolia, Arkansas. Michael, writing under the pen name of wmburrow, is also the creator of HAWKWIND literary magazine. He retired from the Tyler Morning Telegraph as their web editor. Michael was a member of the Southern Oaks Baptist Church and was preceded in death by his only daughter, Jorah Michelle Burrow Long, brother, Jerry Don Burrow, and his precious grandmother, Clara Gill. Michael is survived by his loving wife, Barbara Burrow of Tyler, Texas; sister, Johnette Burrow McDaniel and husband, Jay of Tyler, Texas; brother, James Patrick Burrow and wife, Janet of Alpharetta, Georgia; son-in-law, Frank Long of San Antonio, Texas; and 4 nephews and 1 niece.
