A memorial service for Michael G. Young, age 75 of Hideaway, Texas, is scheduled for 1:00 p.m. Saturday, May 24, 2025 at the Hideaway Lake Community Church with Pastor Louis Mizell officiating.

Mike passed away on Monday, April 28, 2025, in Lindale, Texas. He was born August 14, 1949, in Pittsburgh, Texas to the late G.B. and Elizabeth Jewel (Allen) Young. Mike had lived in Hideaway for the past 8 years where he was a member of Hideaway Lake Community Church and was previously a longtime resident of Highland Village, Texas.
