Memorial services for Pat Reed Burgess are scheduled 12:00 P.M. Saturday, August 27, 2016 in the Hideaway Lake Community Church with Rev. Randy Piatt and Rev. Sam Hughes officiating. Services are under the direction of Caudle-Rutledge-Daugherty Funeral Home in Lindale, Texas. Pat Reed Burgess, 76, was welcomed into the arms of his loving Savior Jesus Christ on August 23, 2016. Pat resided in Baytown, Texas for 45 years. From there, he moved to Hideaway, Texas for 9 years and made his final earthly home in Mineola, Texas. Pat served in the U.S. Air Force then returned to work for U.S. Industrial Chemical, U.S. Steel, and Memorial Baptist Church before finally retiring from Jindal Steel in 2002. Always an airplane enthusiast, he was involved with Civil Air Patrol (Baytown), Experimental Aircraft Association (Gladewater), and had plans to build his own plane. One of Pat's biggest passions was the Salvation Army toy distribution. He also was "Mr. Fix It" to all. He loved building, fixing, organizing, planning, directing and traveling. While his accomplishments were many, he is most loved and remembered as a husband, father, Poppy to his grandchildren, and friend to all. His sense of humor, positive attitude, and contagious laugh lasted until the very end. Through his long, courageous battle with lymphoma, he never complained or grumbled.
