February 14, 1947 - January 4, 2023

On January 4, 2023, Philip (Mike) Littell passed away. He was born in Indianapolis, Indiana on February 14, 1947 to the late Mervin and Erma Littell. After high school, he attended Purdue University, graduated in 1969, and then joined the United States Marine Corps. Mike became a USMC Captain during his service. Mike had one brother, Kenneth Littell, who preceded him in death. Joining EDS as his first employment, he remained with that company over 30 years, serving in many capacities. He also had employment with Hewlett-Packard and Fi Serv. In 1976, he married his wife, Lynn. Together they had two children: Mark Daniel and Heather Marie. The couple always agreed that raising these two wonderful people was the highlight of their lives. Mike loved his family, his work, Western films, and holding leadership roles at church. He enjoyed discussing world history and current events. After retiring, he moved to his lake house at Hideaway Lake, near Lindale, TX. There, he developed an interest in art, fishing (especially with his five grandchildren), grilling out, and bible study at his church. He leaves many who loved him; Mark (son), and his wife, Kiara, of New York and their two daughters, Addison and Raegan, Heather (daughter), and her husband, Phillip, and their three children, Benjamin, Olin, and Charlotte, as well as many friends, work associates, and people along life's journey. 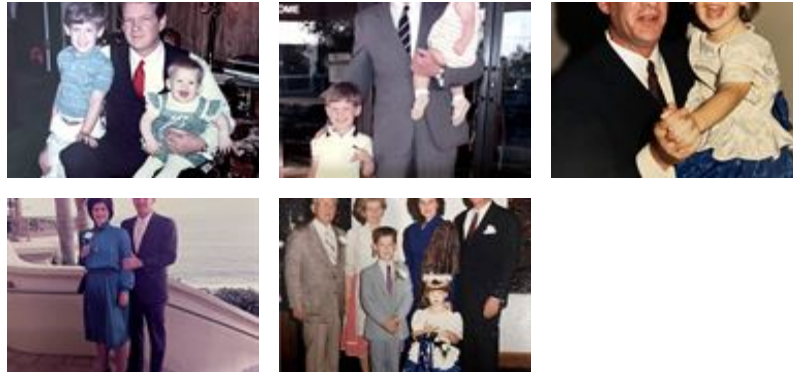
