Funeral services for Randy Willmon, age 53, of Lindale, Texas, are scheduled for 2:00 P.M. Tuesday, March 20, 2018, at the First Baptist Church in Sunnyvale, Texas, with Pastor David Hickey officiating. Interment will follow in the Lindale City Cemetery in Lindale, Texas, with services under the direction of Caudle-Rutledge-Daugherty Funeral Home in Lindale. Randy died Thursday, March 15, 2018, at his home in Lindale. 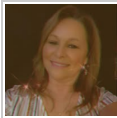

Well, you didn't like it and wanted a dark blue Mustang. The next thing I know, you are getting married and was having your own son. Then another.



Randy, we may have drifted apart but one thing always remained present and that was my deep unconditional love for you. Sometimes I used to wonder why we weren't close after we grew up, but I know now and it had to do with our families dynamics so much could not be done about it. But, I will never forget your eulog at Dennis' funeral and how you spoke about family. You said the message you wanted to share the most was to value your family. Love them the way God loves us in spite of your differences. That we get to pick our friends but that God picks our family and we will see the glory in that one day. I knew you were speaking to me and oh how I wished you could have seen mom and me work things out before you died. I know how hard you prayed for us, but I'm not giving up on this Randy. Maybe from where you are now, you can make miracles happen or put in a special request. Knowing you little brother you're already trying. I love you so much and will think of you every time I pray. Because of you I know where I'm going when I die. Jesus saved me but you brought me to Him. Thank you for this and thank you for loving me no matter how difficult that was at times.

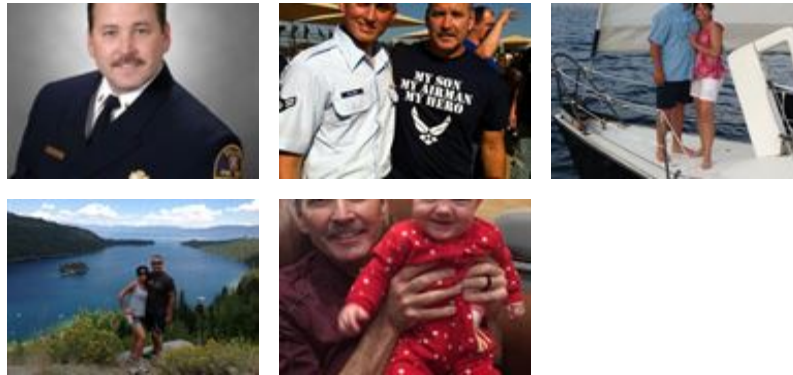
