Funeral services for Raymon Cooksey, age 84, of Tyler, Texas are scheduled for 2:00 P.M. Sunday, January 28, 2018 at the Caudle-Rutledge-Daugherty Funeral Home in Lindale, Texas with Rev. 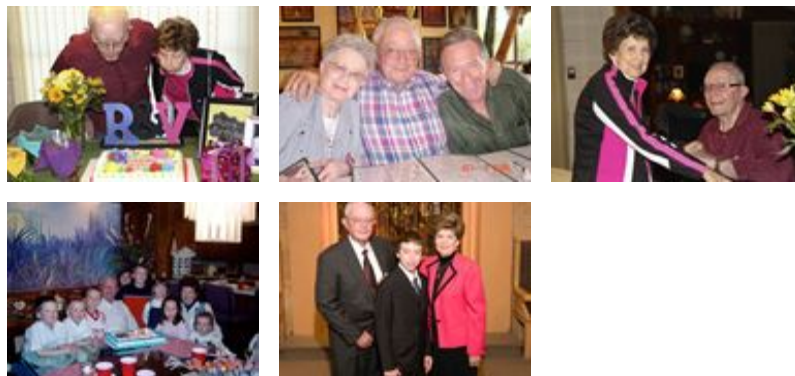
