



Raymond Ellis Proctor

January 23, 1936 - November 9, 2015

Services for Raymond Ellis Proctor, age 79 of Lindale, are scheduled for 2:00 PM Wednesday, November 11, 2015 at Mt. Sylvan Baptist Church with Bro. Bruce Rudd officiating. Interment will follow in the Mt. Sylvan Cemetery. Services are under the direction of Caudle-Rutledge-Daugherty funeral directors. Mr. Proctor died Monday, November 9, 2015 at a Tyler hospital. He was born in Three Rivers, Texas on January 23, 1936 to the late Stoy Eugene and Oleta (Rathke) Proctor. Mr. Proctor was formerly of Flint before becoming a longtime resident of Lindale. He was employed by Richardson Battery Company, was a truck driver for 19 years for Glo-Flame, and was a member and usher at Mt. Sylvan Baptist Church.
