



Robbie Surratt

December 17, 1943 - September 26, 2008

Funeral services for Coach Robbie Surratt, age 64 of Lindale, will be held at 4:30 P.M. Monday, September 29, 2008 in the First Baptist Church of Lindale with Luke Oyler, Robbie Surratt, Jr., Doug Boone and Betsie Surratt officiating. Burial will follow in the Lindale City Cemetery with services under the direction of Caudle-Rutledge Funeral Directors in Lindale. Coach Surratt died Friday night, September 26, 2008, right after Lindale High School's Homecoming. He was born on December 17, 1943 in Omaha, Texas, the son of Orvel Lee & Louise Clayton Surratt. Coach Surratt coached young men for 37 years having coached Texas High School All Stars and then retired in 2007 after 21 years from Lindale High School as their head baseball coach. In 2007 the greatest honor was presented him when the Lindale High School Baseball Field was named the "Robbie Surratt Field". Coach Surratt was a member of the Texas Classroom Teacher Association and Texas Baseball Association. He was preceded in death by his father, Orvel Surratt.

Coach Surratt is survived by his Wife of almost 38 years, Mrs. Betsie Surratt of Lindale; Son & Daughter-in-law, Robbie Lee, Jr. & Susie Surratt of Bridgeport, Texas; 2 Daughters & Sons-in-law, Melissa & Forrest Manning of Lindale, Texas and Shellie & Tim Pettigrew of Lindale, Texas; Mother, Louise Surratt of Omaha, Texas; Brother & Sister-in-law, Donnie & Vickie Surratt of Mt. Vernon, Texas; Sister & Brother-in-law, Connie & Willard Johnson of Bonham, Texas; Grandchildren, Blake Manning, McKenzie Manning, Dylan

Surratt, Sydney Surratt and Kyesen Ripley; and several Nieces and Nephews.
