A funeral and celebration for the life of Dr. Robert G. Tromly, 87, is scheduled for Tuesday, November 29, 2005, 10:00 A.M. in the Hide-A-Way Lake Community Church. "Doctor Bob" as he was affectionately called was born November 10, 1918 in Minot, North Dakota and raised in Butte, Montana. Dr. Tromly graduated from the University of Montana and later the University of Tennessee Medical School. He practiced General Medicine from 1945-1953. He served as a Major in the U. S. Army Medical Corps in Berlin, Germany 1954-1956. He then completed a Residency in Otolaryngology and was board certified in Otolaryngology and Head & Neck Surgery. Dr. Tromly practiced in Dallas from 1963-1995.

He retired to Hide-A-Way in 1995 where he enjoyed golf and fishing. He was a member of Hide-A-Way Community Church, The Lakeside Sunday School Class and a loyal member of the Men's Bible Class.

Preceding Dr. Tromly in death was his beloved wife, Katie; his mother, Mary

Goodyear Tromly; father, Lawrence A. Tromly, Sr.; and his brother, Larry Tromly.
