Robert James Provan passed away July 6, 2006. He was born in Vernon, Texas on September 14, 1944 to James W. Provan, Sr. and Alice Louise Furr Provan. Mr. Provan grew up in Chicago, Illinois where he was diagnosed with polio at the age of five. He graduated from Irving High School, Slippery Rock State College with a Bachelor's of Political Science, and the University of Texas Law School with a Doctorate of Jurisprudence and became a prominent lawyer in the State of Texas.

Mr. Provan is survived by a loving daughter, Michelle J. Provan and 4 brothers, Phillip E. Provan, James W. Provan, Jr., David L. Provan, and John I. Provan. In addition, surviving family members are 4 nephews, 9 nieces, 11 great nieces and 4 great nephews.
