Services for Robert L Sielken, 84, will be held Saturday, October 22, 2005 at Hide-A-Way Lake Community Church at 1:30 p.m. with Dr. Don Anderson presiding. Bob died October 8 asleep in his recliner at his home. He was born January 28, 1921 in Indianapolis, Indiana, to the late Herman Henry Sielken and Nellie Inez Lewis Sielken Traylor. Bob Sielken is preceded in death by his beloved wives Juanita Louise Skinner Sielken in 1976 and Ruth Lewis Wilmoth Sielken in 2003. After playing golf and basketball at Shortridge High School in Indianapolis, Bob was a member of the golf team and graduated from Earlham College (interrupted by service as a Captain in the US Army during WWII). He worked in personnel management in IN, IL, OH, and NJ. He retired to Texas. He moved to Hide-A-Way in July of 1985 when he married Ruth Wilmoth. He had four holes in one including a double eagle, won numerous trophies, and was a member of the Hide-A-Way Men's Golf Association. Although he loved golf, he loved his family and his friends even more. He also served as President of the Tyler Rose Society and served 3 terms on the Hide-A-Way board. He was born a Quaker and was an active member of many churches during his lifetime, including serving Communion at Hide-A-Way Community Church the Sunday before his passing.

Survivors include his sons, Robert L. Sielken Jr. and David Wayne Sielken and their children Robert Selby Sielken (and his daughter Gabrielle Noelani Sielken) and Andrea Jane Sielken Cobos (and her daughter Aubree Camille

Cobos) and Matthew David Sielken and Megan Linn Sielken, respectively. Survivors also include his step-children, Barbara Wilmoth Hinshaw Nolan (and her children Andrew Hinshaw (and his daughter Kaci Hinshaw), Ann Hinshaw , and Jeff Hinshaw), and Richard Wilmoth (and his children Joel Wilmoth (and his daughters Claire and Rebecca and son Joel and his two step-children Morgan and Max Richter), John Wilmoth, and Mary Wilmoth Elliott (and her two sons Sam and Will Elliott and daughter Caroline).
