Mr. McGaughey died on Thursday, January 8, 2015. He was born on September 14, 1936 in Mineola to Robert Samuel and Juanita Wisner McGaughey and was a member of the Holy Family Catholic Church in Lindale.

Robert graduated from Stark High School in Orange, Texas. He enrolled in Lamar University in Beaumont, Texas where he earned the Bachelor of Science Degree in Mathematics. He worked for IBM and then Boeing Company in Seattle where he worked as an engineer and a programmer. In 1968 he entered the Seattle University in Seattle, Washington where he was awarded the M.B.A Degree. After a long association with Boeing, in 1972 he made the big move back to the Texas area. He served as Data Processing Director with Tyler Pipe Industries in Tyler and later moved to the Dallas area and worked as a Systems Manager with Commercial Metals Company.

Robert's wide experience in the business world made him a valued member of the DeVRY Institute in Irving, Texas where he finished out his career.

Professor McGaughey taught Computer Information Systems classes, Robert was an active Catholic, former CCD teacher, and former member of the

Knights of Columbus. Of all the titles Robert held over the years, his most precious were those of husband, Dad, and Papa.

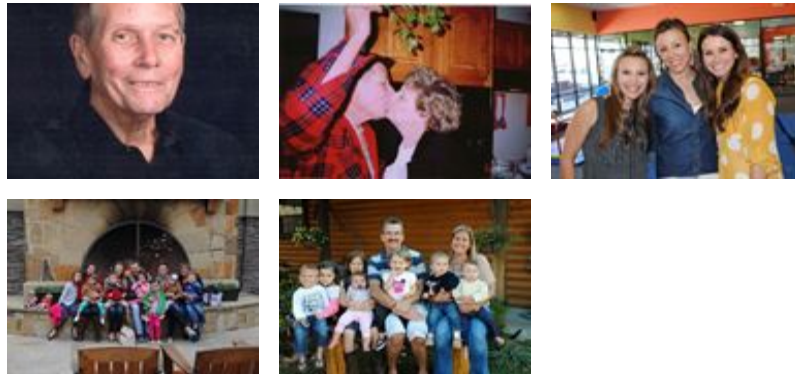
