



## Steve Ehrhardt

Funeral services for Steve Ehrhardt age 89 of Hideaway are scheduled for 10:00 AM Monday, December 28, 2009 in the Caudle-Rutledge Funeral Home Chapel with Rev. Mr. Charles Sylvester officiating. Graveside services will be held at 2:00 PM Monday in the Sacred Heart Cemetery in Rowlett, Texas.

Mr. Ehrhardt was born February 12, 1920 in Atlanta, Georgia the son of the late Clarence T. and Annie (Pace) Ehrhardt. He died Tuesday, December 22, 2009 in a Tyler hospice center. Mr. Ehrhardt was formerly of Dallas, moving to Hideaway in 1996. He was a veteran of World War II, serving in the Army Air Corp as a pilot, holding the rank of Major. He served in the Central Burma, India Burma, and China Offensive campaigns. Mr. Ehrhardt received the American Theater Campaign Medal, American Defense Service Medal, Distinguished Flying Cross Air Medal with 1 Oak Leaf Cluster, Victory Medal, and Asiatic-Pacific Campaign Medal with 3 Bronze Service Stars. He attended Boys High School in Atlanta, Georgia and Georgia Tech. He also received degrees from Eastfield College in Dallas and Texas A&M University in College Station. Mr. Ehrhardt served as a Vice President of Great National Life Insurance Co. of Dallas. He was a member of Holy Family Catholic Church in Lindale and involved in activities at Hideaway Lake.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Ima Ehrhardt and daughter, Laura Key.

Mr. Ehrhardt is survived by Phil and Dana Fielder of Rockwall; grandchildren, Melissa Epps, Tucker and Tanner Fielder; nieces and nephews, Modena and Ron DeBrosse, Stephanie Ehrhardt, Gena and Dave Buford, and Michael Ehrhardt.
