



Thurman Maurice "Mo" Scogin

Funeral Services for Thurman Maurice "Mo" Scogin, age 88 of Hideaway, TX, are scheduled for 11:00 a.m. Friday, May 4, 2018 at the Caudle-Rutledge-Daugherty Funeral Home Chapel in Lindale, TX with Pastor Frank McDaniel officiating. 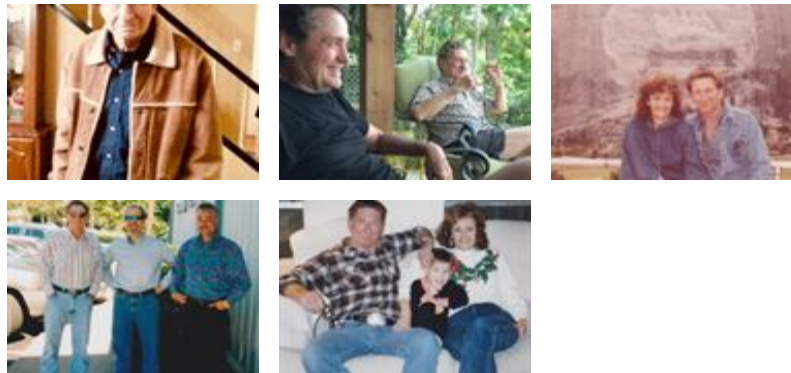
