



Virginia Harrison

January 21, 1919 - September 12, 2015

Memorial services for Mrs. Virginia Harrison, age 96, of Hideaway, Texas are scheduled for 11:00 A.M. Wednesday, September 16, 2015 in the Caudle-Rutledge Funeral Home Chapel in Lindale, Texas with Rev. Herschel Sanders officiating. Mrs. Harrison died Saturday, September 12, 2015 in a Tyler hospice center. Virginia Harrison was born in Carnegie, Oklahoma on January 21, 1919 to James Lester and Nettie Jane (Hampton) Cruse. In 1922, Mother, Father and Virginia packed everything they had into a Model T Ford and moved to Washington State. In 1925, Virginia's sister, Juanita was born, and the next year the family moved to California. In 1929, Virginia's Dad was offered the job of dredging Pearl Harbor, so the family moved to Hawaii for three years. While living on the island of Oahu, Virginia went to Junior High School. She learned to hula dance and performed at the Royal Hawaiian Hotel. She also learned how to swim on Waikiki Beach. After moving back to the states, Virginia met the love of her life, James Edward Harrison, in 1938. They were married in 1939, and "set up house" in Concord, California. Jimmy died in 1990. Virginia continued living in California, but made many trips to Texas to visit family and friends.

In 1999, Virginia moved to Hideaway and met so many wonderful people who she loved to call special friends. She loved Hideaway and felt blessed to call it home.

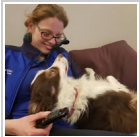
