Mrs. Corriveau died Friday, October 28, 2011 in a Tyler hospice center. Mrs. Corriveau owned and operated Little Eagles Day School for 24 years and was a member of the First Baptist Church where she served as the GA's Director and Children's Choir teacher. She served as President of the Lindale Area Genealogy and History Society, served on the Lindale Historic Preservation Commission Board and Who's Who in Executives and Business. Mrs. Corriveau was also a volunteer genealogist at the Lindale Library.
