



Wanda Jean Garner

October 11, 1936 - January 16, 2014

Funeral services for Wanda Jean Garner, age 77, of Lindale, Texas are scheduled for 2:00 P.M. Monday, January 20, 2014 in the Lindale First Baptist Church with Rev. Tom Buck and Rev. Ronnie Stribble officiating. Interment will follow in the Union Chapel Cemetery near Van, Texas with services under the direction of Caudle-Rutledge Funeral Directors in Lindale, Texas. Mrs. Garner died Thursday, January 16, 2014 at her residence. She was born in Brownsboro, Texas on October 11, 1936 to the late Joe and Myra Smith Palmer Maxwell and attended Lindale Schools briefly and graduated from Forney High School in 1954. She had been employed as a legal secretary in Dallas, Texas area for 20 years, then served as City Secretary for the City of DeSoto, Texas for 19 ½ years retiring in 1997 before returning to live in Lindale area in 1999.
