



Willard Bayne "Buddy" Newton

July 25, 1932 - October 12, 2017

A memorial service for Buddy Newton, 85, of Hideaway Lake, will be held on October 27, 2017 at 2:00 PM at the Hideaway Lake Community Church with Rev. Bill Simmons officiating. Reception to meet the family will be held after the service in the Hideaway Church Gathering Area. Services are under the direction of Caudle-Rutledge-Daugherty Funeral Home in Lindale. Burial will be held on October 28, 2017 at the Asbury Cemetery near Overton Texas at 1:00 PM. Mr. Newton "Buddy" passed away October 12, 2017 after a long battle with Parkinson's disease at his home in Hideaway, Texas surrounded by his family. He was born July 25, 1932 in Lubbock, Texas to Bennie Willard and Sallye (Loper) Newton. Buddy served in the US Navy during the Korean War on Kwajalein Atoll Island. After returning from his service, he attended Texas Tech University graduating in 1957 with his Finance Degree and was a member of the Wrangles/ATO's. He worked for Travelers Insurance Company for 37 years in property claims. Buddy then went to work for the State of Texas as a Hearing Officer for the Worker's Compensation Commission for another 7 Years. He umpired high school and college baseball and officiated high school football for over 38 years. Buddy was active in Kiwanis leadership for over 20 years, a member of Garland Parks and Recreation Board, and a member of Hideaway Lake Board of Directors for 9 years. He served as a member of the Hideaway Lake Community Church Board and volunteered for the up keep and maintenance of the church. Buddy was preceded in death by his parents and daughter, Bronda Lynn Newton Starling. Buddy is survived by his wife of

60 years, Billie Faye (Ritch) Newton; son, Greg Newton; grandchildren, Daniel Newton, Wesley Newton and Ashley Newton Butner & Glen Butner; a great grandson, Colton Butner, sister, Janice & Bob Clark; sister, Doris & Bill Simmons; and son-in-law, Ron Starling.
