



## William Lee Lasseter

Funeral services for William Lee "Bill" Lasseter, age 82, of Hide-A-Way Lake is schedule for 1:30 PM Thursday, October 19, 2006 at Caudle-Rutledge Funeral Home, Lindale.

Mr. Lasseter was born May 20, 1924 in Knox City, TX, and died October 16 in a Tyler hospital. A long-time resident of Hide-A-Way Lake, he is preceded in death by his wife, Mary Ann Bramlette Lasseter.

A pilot for more than 40 years, he began his aviation career in the U.S. Navy and served as a flight instructor during WWII. Following his tour in the Navy, he flew as a crop-duster, and in 1951 he became a commercial pilot for Central Airlines, and subsequently retired from Frontier Airlines. An avid fisherman, he designed and built one of the first prototype fiberglass bass boats, and designed and produced his own line of fishing lures. He also enjoyed hunting and golfing, and was an active member of the Hide-A-Way Lake Kiwanis Club.

Mr. Lasseter is survived by his three children, Lynn Buchanan and husband Buck of Flint, Texas; Bram Lasseter of Cody, Wyoming; and Cindy Payne and husband Trent of Warrensburg, Missouri; six grandchildren, Jennifer Jones of New Orleans, LA; Beau Bigham of New Orleans, LA; Ashley Payne of Dallas, TX; Dusty Lasseter of Cody, WY; Kirk Payne and Hannah Payne of
