Memorial services for William P. "Bill" Brush age 70 of Lindale are scheduled for 11:00 AM Saturday at the Grace Community Church with Pastor Bryan Tema officiating. Mr. Brush was born March 27, 1941 in Jersey City, New Jersey the son of the late William Postley and Mary (Surdukan) Brush. He passed away Tuesday, January 17, 2012 in a Tyler Hospital.

Mr. Brush lived in Lindale since 1986, moving from Katy, was a member of Grace Community Church and a veteran of the U S Air Force serving in the Vietnam War. Mr. Brush had a servant's heart and began serving the Lord as a Deacon in 1966. He continued in the leadership role throughout churches in Oklahoma and Texas. In 1984 Mr. Brush worked with East Texas Baptist Men and drove a truck into Mexico to deliver medical equipment donated by East Texas hospitals.

In 1988 while serving as an Elder at Prairie Creek Baptist Church a new direct missions program was started in Guatemala. Going above and beyond his calling, because of his deep love of the people Mr. Brush's leadership began the expansion of church building projects.

The Lord continued to use Mr. Brush in the Lindale area with his business expertise, which allowed him to assist the start of a Hispanic Church and several ministries. His personal touch and counseling ministry continued

throughout his later days with his clients, friends and family.

Mr. Brush is survived by his wife, Charlotte Brush; son, Bart Brush, grandson, Justin Brush all of Lindale and a brother Stephen Brush of Corona, California.
