



## Winston Jerrim Strehorn

February 13, 2022 - February 17, 2006

Strehorn, Winston "Bill" Jerrim was born on February 13, 1922 and departed this life on February 17, 2006. Born in Denison, Texas, Bill was the younger of two children. He served in the U.S. Army Air Corps during World War II, participated in D-Day invasion, and after his B-24J was shot down, was a Prisoner of War in Germany. Bill lived in the Lake Highlands area of Dallas and worked for Republic Insurance until he and his wife Lee opened their own Strehorn Insurance Agency in 1970. Bill & Lee spent 60 years together, raising two children: Blair Strehorn of Lake Highlands and Cyndy Strehorn, who preceded her dad in death. After retirement, Bill and Lee settled in the Hideaway Lake community. They enjoyed serving at their church, St. Luke's Episcopal in Lindale as well as St. John's Episcopal during their years in Dallas.

"Poppy," as Bill was known to his granddaughters, was loving, funny, and his 84 years gave us much wisdom. Bill shared with us his love of photography, birding, and classical music. He went to Cursillo, and had a close, private relationship with Jesus Christ.

Bill is survived by his wife Violet Lee Laws Strehorn, his son Blair and wife Deborah and her children Nicole, Josh, and Jared McLean of Dallas, Bill's sister Doris Erickson of Fort Worth and her children and grandchildren; his granddaughters: Amy and husband John O'Neil of Allen, Texas; Lisa and

husband Michael Bevins of Durham, NC; Angela and husband Keith Gaston, and great-grandson Sean Jerrim Gaston of Leander, Texas as well as a multitude of friends in Dallas and Lindale.

Christian burial service will be Tuesday, February 21st, at 1 p.m. with reception to follow at St. Luke's Episcopal Church, 16292 FM 849, Lindale, Texas, with the Rev. Bill Cook officiating.
